

- 1 1. That a Presidential General Election was held and conducted on November 8, 2016,
2 the City of Patterson consolidated its election with the with the Presidential General
3 Election conducted on November 8, 2016 in time, form and manner as required by
4 law.
- 5 2. That there were voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election,
6 consisting of precincts established for holding general, state and county elections.
- 7 3. For the position of Mayor at Large, the whole number of registered voters in the City
8 of Patterson was 8825; and of the 8825 registered voters in the City, there were 6264
9 Ballots Cast in the established twelve (12) voting precincts for Mayor; or 70.98
10 percent.
- 11 4. For the position of Council Member, District A, the whole number of registered
12 voters in the City of Patterson was 2345; and of the 2345 registered voters in the City,
13 there were 1692 Ballots Cast in the established two (2) precincts for this District; or
14 72.15 percent.
- 15 5. For the position of Council Member, District C, the whole number of registered
16 voters in the City of Patterson was 2150; and of the 2150 registered voters in the City,
17 there were 1510 Ballots Cast in the established five (5) precincts for this District; or
18 70.23 percent.
- 19 6. That the names of the persons voted for, and the offices of which they were voted,


